## SERMON NOTES

### That You May Believe #26: All There is to Say

“...go tell his disciples and Peter, ‘He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.’” (Mark 16:7)

“I’m going out to fish, Peter told them, and they said, ‘We’ll go with you.’ ... ‘Friends, haven’t you any fish? ... Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some.’ ... ‘Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, ‘It is the Lord!’” (John 21:3, 5, 6, 7)

“...from now on you will fish for people.” (Luke 5:10)

#### Why is This Story the Ending to John’s Gospel?

1. To remind us to always keep \_\_\_\_\_ with the \_\_\_\_\_. (Acts 1:12-24)

“When they landed, they saw a fire of burning coals there with fish on it, and some bread. Jesus said to them, ‘Bring some of the fish you have caught... Jesus said to them, ‘Come and have breakfast.’ None of the disciples dared ask him, ‘Who are you?’ They knew it was the Lord.” (John 21:9-10, 12)

“...I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.” (Matthew 16:18)

(Luke 22:59-61)

2. To remind us not to be \_\_\_\_\_ by our \_\_\_\_\_.  
“Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?” (John 21:15)
