SERMON NOTES

Sermon on the Mount #8: Seeking God's Approval

"Be careful not to do your 'acts of righteousness' in front of others, to be seen by them. If you do, you will have no reward in heaven. So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full. But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you."
(Matthew 6:1-4)

Two Thoughts About Giving the Right Way

"Give generously to them and do so without a grudging heart; then because of this the Lord your God will bless you in all the work and in everything that you put your hand to. (Luke 16:14)

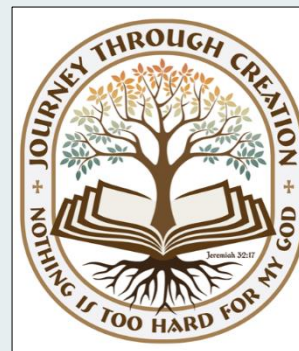
