That You May Believe Part 14: Uncomfortable Truth

“Now a man named Lazarus was sick. He was from Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha. This Mary, whose brother Lazarus now lay sick, was the same one who poured perfume on the Lord and wiped his feet with her hair. So the sisters sent word to Jesus, ‘Lord, the one you love is sick.’” (John 11:1-3)

1. We need to be _____.

“...the wages of sin is death...” (Romans 6:23)

2. We can't save _____.

“When Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went out to meet him, but Mary stayed at home. ‘Lord,’ Martha said to Jesus, ‘if you had been here, my brother would not have died.’” (John 11:20-21)

3. Sometimes Jesus does not save us the way _____.

“But some of them said, ‘Could not he who opened the eyes of the blind man have kept this man from dying?’” (John 11:37)

“Jesus said to her, ‘Your brother will rise again.’ Martha answered, ‘I know he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day.’ Jesus said to her, ‘I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?’ “Yes, Lord, I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, who was to come into the world.” (John 11:23-27)
